Notes from the Deacons:

Bushkill Emergency Corp. is our local ambulance service and our Deacons support them with a yearly donation.

The Corp was started in 1965 and was all volunteers. They cover 400 miles of roads in Monroe County, now as a paid company. The medics, EMTs and drivers are the first people who will most likely save the person's life on the way to the hospital or to a place where a helicopter is waiting to take the patient faster to a hospital.

They rely on donations and memberships to pay most of the costs since insurance only pays a small amount of the cost.

Remember, it is the law to move over to the side of the road when an ambulance is approaching in either direction with their lights on. Someone's life is counting on it and say a prayer for all in the ambulance.
