Financial Report - MaryAnn Conza

We received the Lewis Fund check this month in the amount of \$110,909.32. This yearly distribution is from the Lewis Fund Foundation which is money from Sy & Janet Lewis who bequeathed their estate to four organization, the Reformed Church of Bushkill being one of them. Through their generosity and a Capital Campaign, we were able to build our Church and pay the mortgage with this money.

The Church tithes 10% of its income each month to the Deacons, plus 10% from the Lewis Fund. The Deacons will receive \$11,090.03 from this check, leaving a balance of \$99,818.39. Since our mortgage is paid off, the balance will be held in reserves and used for purchasing items we cannot afford, special projects or programs and occasionally to initiate a staff position, until the budget can fund the position. The remaining amount was never intended to be used to supplement the budget shortfall. The budget must be supported by the people of the congregation.

Right now we are showing a large deficit. We had a large expense for a new lawn mower of \$13,799. This will come from one of our Fund accounts and will reflect on next month's report. Thank You Note from The Angel's Closet



A little over a year ago, The Angel's Closet (TAC) moved into the yellow/green room downstairs. We had outgrown the space we were in and now we have a much larger workspace here. Last year we supplied 178 bundles to mothers in need in Monroe County. So far this year, we have given out 55 bundles. Actually, since 2001, we have given out 3,411 bundles!!

Our bundles have been for newborns through 12 months and have recently decided to include up to 24 months since we have been receiving many calls for these sizes as well.

The bundles consist of diapers, wipes, bath towels and washcloths, receiving blankets, bibs, onesies, sleepers, outfits, socks, hats, sweaters, handmade blanket and quilt and when we have them, board books and a toy.

TAC would like to thank The Reformed Church of Bushkill for their prayers, monetary donations, the lovely donated items in our bin in the narthex and for the wonderful room we have in the church so we can continue to serve our community.
